ਜਾਨਵਰ ਮੈਮੋਰੀ ਗੇਮ Animals Memory Game

Instructions:

- Print the flashcards on cardboard. Cut out the flashcards.
- Shuffle and lay the cards facedown: Take your deck of flashcards and give them a good shuffle. Then, lay them facedown on a table or the floor in a grid-like pattern.
- Take turns flipping two cards: The first player starts by flipping over any two cards of their choice. Remember, the goal is to find matching pairs of animals and say the animal's name in Punjabi.
- Try to find a match: Once two cards are flipped, the player looks for a matching pair of animals. If they find a match, they keep the cards and get another turn to flip two more cards. If the cards don't match, they must be turned face down again, and it becomes the next player's turn.
- Keep playing until all cards are matched: Players take turns flipping pairs of cards, trying to remember where each animal is located. The game continues until all the matching pairs have been found.
- Count the pairs: Once all the cards have been matched, count the number of pairs that each player collected. The player with the most pairs wins the game!
- Remember, the key to success in this game is concentration and a good memory. Have fun playing the animal memory game with your flashcards!
